#### Module 1: The education environment locally and globally

<b>Target participants</b>	Full-time and part-time teaching staff of the self-financed sub-degree and top-up degree sector (the Sector) who wish to have a better understanding of the Sector locally and its counterpart globally.
<b>Aims</b>	To provide participants a general picture on the development of education system locally. Including the position of the Sector within the system; and the trend of development globally. The quality requirements of the Hong Kong education system and quality assurance agencies.
<b>Class arrangements</b>	There will be a total of 3 identical classes.
