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## The Ideal Case: 2 + 2

2- Year Associate Degree Programmes

#### Then

• 2-Year Top-up Degree Programmes

#### OR

 Admission to Senior Year and complete the degree programme in 2 years



# Programme Structure: GE + Major

- GE includes the generic skills such as English,
  Chinese, IT and Quantitative Methods
- 2-Year AD Programme
- Usually 60% GE + 40% "Major" requested by EDB
- 4-Year Degree Programme
- Usually 25% GE + 75% "Major"



#### **GE Structure: Core + Distribution**

- Both AD and Degree Programmes
- Different combinations and ratios for different institutions/universities
- Usually universities have "Unique Themes" especially for the compulsory core subjects



#### **Current Credit Transfer Arrangement**

- Different arrangements by different universities
- "Partial" Block Transfer
- Subject-to-subject Mapping
- Pre-Recognition of Subjects (by nature and ILO)
- Case-by-case Approval
- Some have clear pictures before application and admission
- But some could know the exact transfer credits granted only after admission



## Example 1: HKBU

- A blanket transfer of 12 credits in the distribution requirements
- Usually students get credit transfer of core requirements in English, Chinese, IT and Numeracy if students have completed relevant subjects in AD



### Example 1: HKBU

- However students usually need to take subjects (total 11 credits) in P.E., Public Speaking, History & Civilization, Values & the meaning of Life unless students have completed relevant subjects in AD
- HKBU has also invited AD institutions to apply for subject recognition (but not subjectmapping) the recognized lists are posted on the web



#### **Example 2: CityU**

- AD graduates get "Advanced Standing II" status
- Block Transfer of most core and distribution requirements (no need for subject mapping)
- However students must take (total 12 credits)
  1 English and 3 distribution elective subjects
- No additional credit transfer (but may have subject exemption)



#### Example 3: PolyU

- Block Transfer of most core and distribution requirements (no need for subject mapping)
- Language and Communication Requirements usually will be waived if students have met the equivalent standard in AD
- However students need to take (total 9 credits) 2 distribution elective subjects (with English and Chinese reading and writing as well as China-related requirements), Service Learning and Healthy Lifestyle



#### **Extra Credits => Heavy Burden**

- The above examples are already favorable cases
- Still need 9 to 12 additional GE credits
- In addition, students may need to take 6 to 12 additional credits in Major subjects (because at most 40% of their AD programmes are Major subjects)
- Students need to take 15 to 24 additional credits in two (or three) years



#### Wish: 2 + 2

- Block Transfer of All GE subjects (Core and Distribution)
- 1 to 2 (3 to 6 credits) "tailor-made" Core GE subjects to fulfill University's "Unique Theme"
- Request EDB to change GE subjects of AD programmes to (at least) 50% (to provide room for Major subjects)
- 1 to 2 (3 to 6 credits) additional (foundation)
  Major subjects if needed
- At most 4 additional subjects in two years
