Credit Transfer Framework for Sub-Degree Holders

- In place from Fall 2013-14
- Tailored for sub-degree holders entering 4Y programs
- Up to 60 transfer credits can be granted on admission including:

Category 1	A block transfer of 9 credits* into Common Core Courses: 3 credits each for H, SA, and S&T	Upon receiving block
Category 2	 *cannot count against the SSC requirement in these 3 areas a) 6 transfer credits for the English Communication courses, based on (i) reaching a required language proficiency (i.e. IELTS score of Band 6.0 overall, with all sub-skills scored at 5.5 or above) AND (ii) having completed relevant English-language courses at post-secondary level b) 3 transfer credits for the Chinese Communication course, based on relevant courses taken in the post-secondary program 	transfer credits (Category 1) into the common core, no additional transfer credits into the common core is allowed , except credits to be granted under Category 2
Category 3	Course-credit transfer granted by the relevant course-offering department, based on subject attainments in post-secondary program	
Category 4	A block transfer of 12 unassigned free credits
