


What is General Education @ THEi?

Holistic Approaches

- Orientation programme: help students adjust to the campus learning environment
- Financial assistance / scholarship
- Counselling services at THEi
- CP / EP / ST
- Inclusive programme



- Module exemption and special assessment arrangements
- Learning support

Learning Support within THEi

- Student counsellors: 1st point of contact for SEN students
- Programme leaders / class tutors: assist students in module exemption application, special assessments, and technical aid arrangements
- SEN-Co: work closely with student counsellor, programme leader / class tutors to draw a tailor-made study plan

Case Sharing

SEN Symptoms:

- A Year 2 science student with Autism Spectrum Disorder;
- Rigidity disables the student to conduct team work, but he is unwilling to be outstanding / isolated;
- Difficulty in English writing involving contextual understanding and presentation

Learning Supports:

- Review academic performance and progress
- Supports on assessments (individual coaching, remedial classes, CLE write advice);
- Special approval for adjustments;
- Regular meetings with student counsellor, SEN-Co, class tutor and the student;
- End of semester evaluative meeting and questionnaire;
- Tailor-made four-year study plan
