


What VTE's provide

- Learning environment is immersive, customizable providing engagement and motivation.
- Students can observe, and manipulate the virtual world.
- Safe environments for students to learn repeatable skills training by 'failing' and 'succeeding'.
- Multi user environment



Maximizing learning using VTE

- VR in a VTE combined with gamification improves the user experience:
 - Provide realism,
 - Provide engagement, and
 - Drives motivation
- Gaming with learning focused simulations should contain:
 - Time constraints,
 - Limited resources,
 - Challenges,
 - Excitement,
 - Uncertainty,
 - Anticipation,
 - Fear,
 - Practice.

- Reduce training costs.






