## Challenges

- Diversity of institutions and courses (CC/GE course curricula, number of credits, transcript formats)
- Lack of up-to-date sub-degree CC/GE course information
- CC/GE course administration vs credit transfer
- Relative strength of discipline areas
- Students: need help with course planning
